Presenter Bio: Rana Yaghmaian, PhD, CRC is an Associate Professor and Department Chair of Counselor Education at Portland State University. Dr. Yaghmaian received her PhD in Rehabilitation Psychology from the University of Wisconsin - Madison. Dr. Yaghmaian's research centers the experiences of women of color with chronic illness and disability and their experiences in medical settings, as well as college students of color with disabilities and how they navigate campus support spaces and resources. Her work has been funded by the U.S. Department of Education's Rehabilitation Services Administration and the Spencer Foundation's Racial Equity Grant program. She is passionate about clinical supervision and integrating theory and praxis to train future counselors.
